### **Becoming a member of the Jabalbina Yalanji Aboriginal Corporation**

#### **Who can be a member?**

The Rule Book of the Jabalbina Yalanji Aboriginal Corporation says that anyone:

- over 18, **and**
- an Aboriginal, **and**
- descended from one or more of the Eastern Kuku Yalanji Maja Maja Ngujakarimun (apical ancestors in descent groups) listed in schedule 2 of the Rulebook, **or**
- recruited by adoption, in accordance with the traditional laws and customs of the Eastern Kuku Yalanji people can apply to become a member of the corporation.

#### **How do I become a member?**

All applications for membership of the corporation must be in writing. Please fill out an application form and send it to:

The directors will consider new membership applications at their next meeting.

All persons who become a member of Jabalbina will be put on the register of members. You must provide all the information required on the membership application form to assist us in doing this.

#### **Why should I be a member?**

Jabalbina has been set up to manage Yalanji business on behalf of all Eastern Kuku Yalanji. You do not have to be a member to benefit.

However, if you are a member, the corporation knows to send you notice of general meetings and other information. You get to have a say at meetings, can vote and can nominate to be a Director of Jabalbina. You can also access some of the records of Jabalbina.

#### **Do I have any obligations as a member?**

People who are members of the Jabalbina Yalanji Aboriginal Corporation have rights and responsibilities. These are detailed in the Jabalbina Rule book which can be accessed through [www.oric.gov.au](http://www.oric.gov.au) (search for ICN 7002), or by contacting the Jabalbina office.

### **The Jabalbina Rule Book States:**

#### 5.2.2 who can apply to become a member (eligibility for membership)

A person who is eligible to apply for membership must be an individual who is

- (a) 18yrs of age; and
- (b) An aboriginal
- (c) Decended from one or more of the Eastern Kuku Yalanji Maja Maja Ngujakarimun (apical ancestors in decent groups) listed in schedule 2 (see below); or
- (d) Recruited by adoption, in accordance with the traditional laws and customs of the Eastern Kuku Yalanji people.
